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CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL	
1.	The applicant must comply with all applicable Acts, regulations, by laws, proclamations and orders and with any lawful direction or orders given by or for the Council or any other competent authority.
2.	The maximum daily discharge shall not exceedkL/d The maximum instantaneous discharge rate shall not exceedL/s or L/h. A suitable method of restricting the flow rate to the figure stated above shall be provided by the applicant.
3.	If, in the opinion of Council, the septage waste being discharged does not comply with the conditions contained herewith; or is adversely affecting the performance of the sewage treatment plant; the sewerage system; or the ecological system in the waters, land or area receiving sewage treatment works effluent; the company shall forthwith, on receipt of notice in writing from Council to this effect, take remedial action by modifying the characteristics of the septage, reducing the amount of the liquid trade waste or ceasing to discharge the septage as directed by notice from Council.
4.	The following substances are prohibited from being discharged to the sewerage system: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Organochlorine weedicides, fungicides, pesticides, herbicides and substances of a similar nature and/or wastes arising from the preparation of these substances. • Organophosphorus pesticides and/or waste arising from the preparation of these substances. • Per- and poly-fluoroalkyl substances (PFAS). • Any substances liable to produce noxious or poisonous vapours in the sewerage system. • Organic solvents and mineral oil¹. • Any flammable or explosive substances¹. • Discharges from 'bulk fuel depots'. • Discharges from chemicals and/oil storage areas. • Natural or synthetic resins, plastic monomers, synthetic adhesives, rubber and plastic emulsions. • Roof, rain, surface, seepage or ground water, unless specifically permitted (clause 137A of the Local Government (General) Regulation 2005). • Solid matter¹. • Disposable products including wet wipes, cleaning wipes, colostomy bags, cat litter and other products marketed as flushable. • Any substance assessed as not suitable to be discharged to the sewerage system. • Waste liquids that contain pollutants at concentrations, which inhibit the sewage treatment process—refer <i>Australian Sewage Quality Management Guidelines</i>, June 2012, WSAA. • Any other substances listed in a relevant regulation.
