

Kerbside Bin Guide

FOGO Green-Lid Bin

All food scraps

Fruit, vegetables, meat, fish, bones, eggs, dairy, tea leaves, coffee grounds, bread, rice, pasta, left-overs and expired food.

Garden organics

Grass clippings, flowers and weeds, prunings and branches (up to 15cm diameter).

Caddy liners

Only Council provided cornstarch caddy liners.



Recycling Yellow-Lid Bin

Cardboard

Including packing boxes, pizza boxes, gable topped milk and juice cartons.

Empty bottles and jars

Bottles and jars, rinsed and lids off. Empty yoghurt, ice cream, ineligible water and soft drink, milk, shampoo, detergent and sunscreen containers.

Paper

Newspaper, magazines, paper, junk mail and window envelopes.



Residual Red-Lid Bin

Landfill

Non-hazardous household rubbish.

Soft plastics

Glass

Mirrors, crockery, glasses, windows.

Nappies

Pet waste and kitty litter

Toys



Not in the FOGO Bin

Plastic or degradable bags, food packaging, pet waste, kitty litter, clothing, shoes, threated timber, pizza boxes or cardboard.

Not in the Recycling Bin

Soft plastics, plastic bags, food waste, light bulbs, mirrors, crockery or drinking glasses.

For Your Information

Polystyrene, clothing and shoes

You can dispose of clothing, shoes, and polystyrene for **free** at Whylandra Waste and Recycling Centre.
