The Mayor is unable to use his Mayoral Powers of necessity between council meetings for this matter as it does not fit within the policy making function, nor does it meet the definition of 'urgency' under the Local Government Act 1993 (LGA) – S226(d).

REPORT

Council resolved at its last meeting held 24 October 2024, the four voting delegates for the Local Government NSW Annual Conference 2024.

Councillor K Richardson has now advised that she is now unable to attend. Confirmation was received by Office of Local Government that council is required to call an Extraordinary Council meeting as this situation does not meet the threshold for the Mayor to use his Mayoral powers of necessity between Council meetings under the Local Government Act, i.e. a nomination for a voting delegate doesn't fit within a policy making function, nor does it meet the definition of 'urgency':

LGA - Section 226 - Role of Mayor

(d) to exercise, in cases of necessity, the policy-making functions of the governing body of the council between meetings of the council,

An Extraordinary Council meeting has been called for Council to determine a new voting delegate so that council can meet the deadline for notifying LGNSW of the voting delegates.
