Community Engagement Snapshot

On Thursday 24 April 2024, Council endorsed the Draft 2024/2025 Budget, Delivery Program and Operational Plan, Fees and Charges and associated documents for Public Exhibition.

Our engagement intent was to **INVOLVE** the community, in developing a financially sustainable Budget and associated documents within our Intergrated Planning and Reporting framework. YourSay facilitated all engagement activities, while targeted plans for Communications & Marketing ensure residents remained informed on key highlights, impacts or messaging.

YourSay supported a range of ways to view and understand the documents, including location based fact sheets, key themes, video content and a questions and answer tool, providing community an opportunity to seek clarification before submitting their formal feedback. The formal submission however required community to join YourSay to ensure engagement continued beyond the public exhibition.

A summary of the engagement activities for community participation are highlighted below.
